WHEREAS, it is proposed by the congregation of the Broad Street Methodist Episcopal Church of Columbus, Ohio, to erect a church building at the south west corner of Broad Street and Cassady Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, and

WHEREAS, it has been suggested to council that said congregation will request that a special permit be granted by council for the erection of said church at said location which is within the district classified under the Zoning Ordinance of the Village of Bexley as Class 1 or single family house district, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the Council does hereby express its appreciation of the great civic, moral and religious improvement to the Village which will be represented by the construction of this church at the above location, and does hereby assure the congregation of the Broad Street Methodist Episcopal Church that such special permit will be granted by council, as provided in Section 5 of the Zoning Ordinance of the Village, upon application therefor, trusting that in the preparation of the plans for such church the existing set-back lines applying to residence properties within said district, as provided by said Zoning Ordinance, will be adhered to, to the end that the beauty of the neighborhood may not only be maintained, but enhanced by this structure.

Section 2. That the Clerk be, and is hereby, instructed to certify a copy of this resolution to the official board of said congregation.
