

RESOLUTION NO. 521.

WHEREAS, in the construction of sanitary sewer and pumping station in Sewer District No. 6, as provided in an Ordinance No. 552, Determining to proceed with said improvement, passed January 13th, 1925, on account of excessive ground water it has been found by the engineer of the Village to be necessary to substitute cast iron pipe for vitrified sewer as called for in the contract for said improvement, for a distance of approximately 400 feet beginning at said pumping station, which cast iron pipe will cost more than said vitrified sewer, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That said cast iron pipe be substituted for the vitrified sewer for a distance of approximately 400 feet beginning at said pumping station and that the cost of said pipe at the Columbus yards of the United States Cast Iron Pipe Company be allowed to and paid to said contractor and that same be included as a part of the cost of said improvement and assessed upon the benefited property as provided in Ordinance No. 552.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
