AN ORDINANCE NO. 549.

The levy special assessments for the improvement of Ardmore Read between Bread Street and Fair Avenueby grading, curbing and impreving the readway thereof with brick, asphalt, situlithic, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary storm sowers and a six (6) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants and connections.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving
Ardmore Read between Broad Street and Fair Avenue by grading, curbing and improving
the readway thereof with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, concrete or seme other form
of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sterm sewers and a six (6) inch
water line with necessary fire hydrants and connections, pursuant to and in accordance
with an Ordinance No. 463, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by
Council on the 8th. day of January, 1924, amounting in the aggregate to Forty-two
Thousand, Mine Hundred Dollars (\$42,900.00) as reported to this council on the 3rd.
day of December, 1924, by the Beard heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments,
notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be, and the
same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and
assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement the
several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the

ef land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments, with interest at the rate of 520 per amum, from March 1st, 1925. All Gash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
