AN ORDINANCE NO. 552.

Determining to proceed with the construction of sanitary sewers and pumping station in District No. 6.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction
of all the sewers and the pumping station, with necessary machinery and apparatus,
previded for in a general plan for the sewerage of the following described territery in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, known as Sewer District No. 6, which is
bounded as follows:

Being the territory bounded on the south by the center line of Broad Street, on the west by Alum Creek, on the north by the north line of Clifton Avenue, and on the east by the west line of Bullitt Park Addition.

which general plan was adopted on the 7th. day of October, 1924, and is now on file in the office of the Clerk of said Village. That said improvement be constructed pursuant to a Resolution No. 436, passed on the 11th. day of Nevember, 1934, and in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Engineer of the Village, new on file in the office of the Clerk of said Village and that said sewers be of vitrified pipe.

Section 2. Be it further ordained that the whole cost of said improvement, in accordance with the agreement heretofere filed by the swners of all the lots and lands contained in said Sewer District No. 6, shall be assessed in propertion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: Being all the lots and lands contained within the limits of said district, which said lots and lands are hereby described to be specially benefited by said improvement, in an amount equal to the cost thereof, and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of the preliminary and other surveys, the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of said notices, and the cost of construction, together with interest on notes or bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the same rate that shall be berne by the bends to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; provided that the owner of any property assessed may,

at his eption, pay such assessments in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 4. That the Clerk be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
