Accepting deed of Simon A. Singer and Grace G. Singer, his wife, for part of Lets Numbers 262 and 361 of Riders Heirs' Addition in the Village of Bexley.

WHEREAS, Simen A. Singer and Crace G. Singer, husband and wife, have executed their deed to the Village of Bexley, for that part of Lots Numbers 262 and 361 of Riders Heirs' Addition lying between the center line of Charles Street and the following line, to-wit:
