BE IT ORD.INED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving

Elm avenue between Dawson Avenue and Cassady Avenue by grading, curbing and improving

the readway thereof with brick, asphalt. bitulithic, concrete or some other form

of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sterm sewers and a six inch

water line with necessary fire hydrants and connections, pursuant to and in accordance with an ordinance No. 465, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed

by the council on the 15th day of January, 1924, amounting in the aggregate to

Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$8,300.00) as reported to this Council on

the 3rd. day of December, 1924, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said

assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by

law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is

hereby, levied and assessed upon the lets and lands bounding and abutting upon said

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
