

AN ORDINANCE NO. 557.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Elm Avenue between Dawson Avenue and Cassady Avenue by grading, curbing and improving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary storm sewers and a six (6) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants and connections.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Elm Avenue between Dawson Avenue and Cassady Avenue by grading, curbing and improving the roadway thereof with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary storm sewers and a six inch water line with necessary fire hydrants and connections, pursuant to and in accordance with an ordinance No. 465, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by the council on the 15th day of January, 1924, amounting in the aggregate to Eight Thousand, Three Hundred Dollars (\$8,300.00) as reported to this Council on the 3rd. day of December, 1924, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

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Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments, with interest at the rate of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum, from March 1st, 1925. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

NOTICE OF STREET ASSESSMENT.
Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessment of the cost of improving Ardmore Road from Fair Avenue to Broad Street, Cassingham Road from Fair Avenue to Broad Street, Elm Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue, Roosevelt Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street by grading, curbing and paving the roadway thereof with asphalt, constructing the sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for each improvement, constructing water mains and connections from same in said streets to the inner line of the curb, on the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith as set forth in resolutions and ordinances providing for said improvements, have been made and reported to council and said estimated assessments are now on file in the office of the Clerk of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein.
