## AN ORDINANCE NO. 558.

By Mr. O. C. Manly.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Bread Street between rarkview avenue and a point Four Hundred (400) feet west of the west line of Cheek Brothers addition in the Village of Bexley, by constructing an eight (8) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY? STATE OF CHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving

Broad Street between Parkview avenue and a point Four Hundred (400) feet west of the

west line of Cheek Brothers Addition in the Village of Bealey, by constructing an

eight (8) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants, pursuant to and in accordance

with an Ordinance No. 525, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed

by council on the 9th day of September, 1924, amounting in the aggregate to Sixty
four Hundred Dellars (\$6400.00), as reported to this council on the 11th day of

December, 1924, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment,

notice of filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be, and the

same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and

assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, except

Lot Number Six (6) of Block Number Nine (9) of Bullitt Park Extension, the several

mounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description

of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

and it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lets and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in propertion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot emparcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments, with interest

at the rate of 52% per annum, from April 1st, 1925. All cash payments shall be made te the Treasurer ef said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the auditer of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
