

AN ORDINANCE NO. 561.

Accepting deeds of Kathrya R. Skinner and husband and Frederick C. Anthony and wife for easement in real estate hereinafter described.

WHEREAS, Kathrya R. Skinner and Walter W. Skinner, her husband, have executed their deed to the Village of Bexley, and Frederick C. Anthony and Ida Anthony, his wife, have executed their deed to said Village of Bexley, granting an easement in and over the following respective tracts of real estate, situate in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio, and Village of Bexley, to-wit:

1st. Tract: Beginning at a point 127.35 feet west of the west line of Dawson Avenue and 153.59 feet south of the south line of Sherwood Road; thence westerly and parallel with Sherwood Road and 153.59 feet distant therefrom, 57.75 feet to a point; thence southerly and parallel with Dawson Avenue 7.5 feet to a point; thence easterly and parallel with Sherwood Road and 161.09 feet distant therefrom 57.75 feet to a point; thence northerly and parallel with Dawson Avenue 7.5 feet to the place of beginning.

2nd. Tract: Beginning at a point located 127.35 feet west of the west line of Dawson Avenue and 153.59 feet south of the south line of Sherwood Road; thence westerly and parallel with Sherwood Road and 153.59 feet distant therefrom, 61.6 feet to a point; thence southerly and parallel with Dawson Avenue 7.5 feet to a point; thence easterly and parallel with Sherwood Road and 161.09 feet distant therefrom, 61.6 feet to a point; thence northerly and parallel with Dawson Avenue 15 feet to the place of beginning, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interests of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of said Kathrya R. Skinner and husband, and of said Frederick C. Anthony, and wife, bearing date of December 26th, 1924, and December 23rd, 1924, respectively, conveying to the Village of Bexley an easement in the above described premises for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating, repairing therein sewer, water and gas pipes, electric light and telephone wires and poles and for such other municipal purposes to which same may be put, be, and the same are hereby, accepted and the clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deeds the acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
