

ORDINANCE NO. 573.

Granting permission to Joseph H. Outhwaite to tap sanitary sewer and water main at the intersection of Maryland and Stanbery Avenues.

Whereas, Joseph H. Outhwaite, the owner of a tract of land being approximately 170 feet off of the north end of 86 feet^{or} of the west side of Lot Number Thirty-five (35) of the Subdivision of Anton Ruhl Estate in the Village of Bexley, located on the north side of Maryland Avenue has petitioned for permission to tap the sanitary sewer and water main now at the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Stanbery Avenue for the sewerage and water supply to the dwelling house which he is constructing upon said premises, and has signed in writing a waiver on behalf of himself, his heirs and assigns, agreeing with the village that when that part of the system of sewerage designed for said Village, or water main, shall be constructed in Maryland Avenue eastwardly from the present termini, the above described premises may be assessed for its proper portion of the cost of such sewer and water main, and therein waiving the right to claim exemption from such assessments on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate sewerage and water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said Joseph H. Outhwaite in consideration of said waiver and said agreement is hereby granted permission to tap into said sanitary sewer and water main now located at the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Stanbery Avenue for the sewerage and water service of the dwelling house now being constructed upon the premises hereinabove described and to lay at his own ^{expense} and under the supervision of the Street Commissioner of the Village of Bexley, the necessary sewer and water line to connect said premises therewith with necessary taps.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
