

AN ORDINANCE NO. 582.

Granting permission to Gertrude Heinmiller to tap sanitary sewer and water main in right of way in easement in rear of Lot No. 16 and east one-half of Lot No. 15 in Block No. 5, Bexley Highlands Addition in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, Gertrude Heinmiller is the owner of Lot No. 16 and the east one-half of Lot No. 15 of Block No. 5 in Bexley Highlands Addition and has petitioned for permission to tap the sanitary sewer and the water line now in the easement in the rear of said premises draining into the sewer and water line in the alley between Bryden Road and Bexley Park Road just west of Delgard Lane ~~for the purpose~~ for the purpose of providing sewerage and water supply to the dwelling house which she is now constructing on said premises and has signed in writing a waiver on behalf of herself, her heirs and assigns, agreeing with the Village that when that part of the system of sewerage designed for said village, or water main, shall be constructed in said easement, the above described premises may be assessed for its proper proportion of the cost of such sewer and water main and therein waived the right to claim exemption from such assessment on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate sewerage and water service, NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said Gertrude Heinmiller, in consideration of said waiver and said agreement, is hereby granted permission to tap into said sewer and the water main hereinabove described for the sewerage and water service of the dwelling house now being constructed upon her premises hereinabove described, same to be done at her expense and under the supervision of the street commissioner of the Village of Bexley.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
