

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 590

Providing for a contract with the City of Columbus, Ohio, for water supply.

WHEREAS, the contract of the Village of Bexley with the City of Columbus, Ohio, providing for a water supply to said Village expired on the 1st. day of April, 1925, and

WHEREAS, a contract has been submitted to the Village by the Director of Service of the City of Columbus, Ohio, proposing to furnish water to the Village upon the terms and conditions as contained in said former contract for a period of two years beginning April 1st, 1925, which said contract will be for the best interests of said Village to accept, NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of Public Affairs of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, be, and are hereby, authorized to enter into said contract with the City of Columbus, Ohio, in the name of and on behalf of the Village, for a water supply for the term of two years beginning April 1st, 1925, upon the terms and conditions contained in said contract and the proper officials of said Board of Trustees are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract in duplicate and the proper officials are hereby authorized and directed to issue the vouchers for the amounts becoming due under said contract as the same respectively become due.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
