

AN ORDINANCE NO. 600.

Accepting deed of easement of Ross W. Cheek and Lester E. Cheek for sewer purposes.

WHEREAS, Ross W. Cheek and Lester E. Cheek and their respective wives have executed their deed of easement to the Village of Bexley in and through the following described premises in said Village of Bexley, Ohio, to-wit:

Being a strip of land five (5) feet in width off of the north sides of Lots Numbers 1 and 2 and five (5) feet off of the south side of Lots Numbers 3 and 12 of Cheek Brothers Addition to said Village of Bexley, for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating sewers through any part thereof and the right to enter thereon for the purpose of maintaining and repairing same, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of said Ross W. Cheek and Lester E. Cheek and their respective wives, bearing date of April 13th, 1925, conveying to the Village of Bexley an easement in and through the above described premises for sewer purposes be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed, and acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
