

AN ORDINANCE NO. 601.

Accepting deed of easement for sewer of the Board of Education of the Village School District of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, over and through the following real estate situated in said Village of Bexley, Ohio, to-wit:

Being a strip of ground ten (10) feet in width, the center line of which is described as follows:
Beginning at a point in the north line of Lot No. fifty(50) of Rownd and Knauss' Parkview Addition in the Village of Bexley, which point is eight (8) feet west of the north east corner of the 30 foot tract of ground in said lot belonging to said Board of Education of the Village School District of the Village of Bexley; thence southerly and parallel with the east line of said 30 foot tract 210 feet to a point; thence westerly and parallel with and 10 feet from the north line of the school grounds, belonging to said Board of Education, 208.5 feet to a point; thence southerly to a point in the north property line of Main Street, said point being 13.5 feet east of the south west corner of the school grounds belonging to said Board of Education, said southwest corner being also the northwest corner of Lot No. one (1) of G. H. Fussings' Subdivision; for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a 12 or 15 inch sewer in said above described premises, including the right to clean, repair and care for said sewer, together with the right of access to said tract for said purpose, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BESELEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. that said deed of easement of said Board of Education of the Village School District of the Village of Bexley, Franklin County, Ohio, bearing date of March 30th, 1928, conveying to the Village of Bexley an easement in and over the above described premises, subject to the terms and conditions therein contained, be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed an acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the record-

er's Office, Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from
and after the earliest period allowed by law.
