

AN ORDINANCE NO. 603.

Accepting deed of easement of the Rt. Rev. James J. Hartley, Bishop of Columbus, Ohio, for sewer and sewer pumping station purposes.

WHEREAS, the Rt. Rev. James J. Hartley, Bishop of Columbus, Ohio, has executed his deed of easement to the Village of Bexley in and through four certain parcels of real estate, being parts of premises now belonging to said Bishop of Columbus, Ohio, as described by deed of record in D. B. 767, pages 166 and 167, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, said premises being between Clifton Avenue and Broad Street, as said four parcels are particularly described in said deed for easement, bearing date of May 9th, 1925, said easement being for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, operating and repairing storm and sanitary sewers and a pumping station thereon, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of said Rt. Rev. James J. Hartley, Bishop of Columbus, Ohio, bearing date of May 9th, 1925, conveying to the Village of Bexley, easements in and through the above mentioned four parcels of land for sewer and sewer pumping station purposes, be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed the acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
