## AN ORDINANCE NO. 607.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of certain street and avenues in the Village of Bexley, by constructing water lines therein with necessary fire hydrants and water connections.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of the following streets and avenues in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, by constructing water lines therein between Caroline Avenue and Delmar Drive as follows, to-wit:

Drexel Avenue, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein; Walmut Street, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein; Dawson Avenue, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein; Cassady Avenue, by constructing a twelve (12) inch water line therein and Delmar Drive, by constructing a six('6) inch water line connecting said above mains with the existing main now in Columbia Avenue, said lines hereinabove provided constituting but one improvement; also constructing the necessary fire hydrants and making water connections to the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon said lines in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles prepared by the engineers of the Village and now in file in the office of the Village Clerk, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles are hereby approved.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from said improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the improvement and the solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less firm on per cent (15%) thereof shall be assessed in proportion to the bonefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the special assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal, annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That said Village may borrow money and issue notes due and payable not later than two years from the date of issue, in anticipation of the levy of said special assessments and of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection thereof as provided in Section 3914 of the General Code of Ohic. Said notes shall not exceed in amount that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which said special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That bonds of said Village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the property fronting and abutting thereon.

Section 7. That the Village's portion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds issued by said village in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. That the Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
