

AN ORDINANCE NO. 609.

To amend Section 4 of Ordinance No. 572, passed March 10th, 1925, and being entitled an ordinance to provide for the issue and sale of bonds in the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for the purpose of paying the Village's share of the cost and expense of improving sundry streets, roads and avenues, by grading, curbing, paving and constructing water lines and sewers therein, to-wit:

Montrose Avenue from Main Street to Charles Street;
Cassingham Road From Main Street to Charles Street; Brentwood Road from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lane; Vernon Road from Astor Avenue to Livingston Avenue; Roche Avenue from Astor Avenue to Livingston Avenue and Remington Road from Broad Atreet to a point 174 feet south of the south line of Powell Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That Section 4 of said Ordinance No. 572, passed March 10th, 1925, be, and the same is hereby, amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That upon the sale of said bonds any premium and accrued interest realized therefrom and the amount hereinabove provided for interest requirements until taxes are collected and available, shall be paid to the Sinking Fund Trustees to be applied to the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds. The par value realized from the sale of said bonds shall be deposited in the Village Treasury to the credit of "Sundry Street Bond Fund " and shall be disbursed from said Fund on proper vouchers in payment of the Village's part of the cost of the improvement aforesaid for which purpose said money is hereby appropriated.

Section 2. That said Section 4 of Ordinance No. 572 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
