

AN ORDINANCE NO. 610.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO;

Section 1. That when sidewalks are constructed on Main Street between Roche Avenue and Roosevelt Avenue, in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council, and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. Said sidewalks when constructed shall be 5 feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 1 foot from the property line. The grade of the inside edge, or edge next to the lot line, shall be as follows;

Beginning at the east property line of Roche Avenue, Station 0400 and elevation 110.19; thence easterly with a 2.00% ascending grade 45.5 feet, elevation 111.10; thence easterly with 0.586% descending grade 241 feet to the west property line of Vernon Road and elevation 109.65; thence level 50 feet to the east property line of Vernon Road, elevation 109.65; thence easterly with a 1.047% descending grade 286.38 feet to the west property line of Roosevelt Avenue and elevation 106.70.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
