

AN ORDINANCE NO. 611

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That when sidewalks are constructed on Mound Street between Pleasant Ridge Avenue and Euclaire Avenue, in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council, and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk,

Section 2. Said sidewalks when constructed shall be 5 feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 2 feet from the property line. The grade of the inside edge, or edge next to the lot line, shall be as follows;

Beginning at the west property line of Euclaire Avenue, Station 0+00 and Elevation 96.85; thence westerly with a 0.30% ascending grade to Station 1+43, Elevation 97.28; thence westerly with a 0.70% ascending grade to the east property line of Pleasant Ridge, Station 6+95 and elevation 101.14.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
