

AN ORDINANCE NO. 612

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That when sidewalks are constructed on Astor Avenue between College Avenue and Pleasant Ridge Avenue, in the Village of Bexley Ohio, said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by Council, and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. Said sidewalks when constructed shall be 5 feet in width with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{8}$ ths of an inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, 10 feet from the property line. The grade of the inside edge, or edge next to the lot line, shall be as follows:

Beginning at the east property line of Collage Avenue,
Station 0+00 and elevation 93.20; thence easterly with a
Should be 1.40% 1.40% ascending grade to Station 2+00, elevation 94.60;
thence easterly with a 0.95% ascending grade to the west
property line of Plaesant Ridge Avenue, Station 6+22 and
elevation 98.60.

The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
