

AN ORDINANCE NO. 614.

By Mr. Manly.

Determining to proceed with the construction of a relief and intercepting sanitary sewer for the sewerage of part of Sanitary Sewer Districts 1 and 4.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of a 15 inch intercepting sewer along the following described route:

Beginning at the sanitary sewer manhole in the intersection of Main Street at Parkview Avenue; thence in a north easterly direction to a point 7 feet north of the north curb of Main Street and 22.7 feet east of the east curb of Parkview Avenue; thence easterly and 7 feet distant from said north curb of Main Street to a point 11 feet east of the south east corner of Lot Number one(1) of G. N. Tussing's Subdivision; thence northerly 404 feet to a point; thence easterly 211 feet to a point; thence northerly to the center line of Bryden Road,

and a twelve (12) inch relief sewer along the following described route:

Beginning at the terminus of the Fifteen (15) inch intercepting sewer and connecting therewith in the center of Bryden Road; thence north easterly to a point 40 feet north of the north curb of Bryden Road and 13 feet west of the west curb of Columbia Avenue; thence northerly and 13 feet distant from the said west curb of Columbia Avenue 1192.5 feet to a point; thence north easterly to the present sanitary sewer manhole in the center of Columbia Avenue.

The boundaries of that part of Districts Nos. 1 and 4 so to be improved are embraced within the following described lots and lands, to-wit:

Being Lots Nos. 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, and 32 of First Bullitt Park Place Addition.

Lots Nos. 33, 34, 35, 36, 37 and 38 of Second Bullitt Park Place Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 11, 12, 29, and 30 of Hansberger-Marion-Berry & Company's Seneca Park Place Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41 and 42 of Bullitt Park Extension Addition, Amended.

Lots Nos. 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and

29 of the Amended Plat of Blocks Nos. 14, 15, 16 and 17 of Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11 of Block No. 14 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of Block No. 15 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of Block No. 16 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of Block No. 17 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of Block No. 18 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of Block No. 19 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 of Block No. 20 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 7, 8 and 9 of Block No. 21 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Block No. 22 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of Block No. 23 in Bullitt Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, and 18 in Powell's Parkview Addition.

Lots Nos. 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48 and 49 of Rownd and Knauss Parkview Addition.

Lots Nos. 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 and 21 of Bexley Park Addition.

Lots Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 of Sarah Bowman's Subdivision of Lot No. 37 of Rownd & Knauss' Parkview Subdivision.

Section 2. Said sewers with the necessary house connections for lots fronting and abutting upon said improvement shall be constructed pursuant to a Resolution No. 457. finding it necessary to make said improvement, adopted April 14th, 1925, and in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, on file in the office of the Clerk of said Village and said sewers shall be of vitrified pipe.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon all the lots and lands hereinabove in Section 1. described, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement shall include the cost and expense of preliminary and other surveys, the printing and

and publishing of notices, resolutions, and ordinances required, the serving of such notices, and the cost of construction, together with interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds issued in anticipation of the collection thereof; providing that the owner of any property assessed may, at his option, pay such assessments in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessment ordinance upon due notice being given.


Section 5. That bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6. That to pay the remainder of the cost of said improvement the bonds of the Village shall be issued and sold as provided by law.

Section 7. That the Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement as provided by law.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
