

AN ORDINANCE NO. 617.

To remit special assessments for the construction of sanitary and storm sewers on Lot No. 2 of Rudolph Fairwood Addition Addition and to order the payment of certain taxes thereon.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bexley has heretofore, by a proceeding in the Probate Court of Franklin County, Ohio, appropriated Lot No. 2 of Rudolph Fairwood Addition Addition, formerly belonging to Emma E. Dempsey, which premises are subject to a special assessment of \$14.09 and interest for the construction of a sanitary sewer and an assessment of \$23.36 and interest for the construction of a storm sewer; also taxes and penalties amounting to \$58.47, and

WHEREAS, said premises are now the property of the Village of Bexley and said lien should be removed therefrom, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the special assessment for the construction of sanitary sewer in the sum of \$14.09 and interest, and the special assessments for the construction of Storm sewer in the sum of \$23.36 and interest against said Lot No. 2 of Rudolph Fairwood Addition Addition be, and the same hereby are, remitted and withdrawn and the Auditor of Franklin County is authorized to cause same to be cancelled and withdrawn from the Duplicates of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. That the taxes and penalties assessed against said premises in the sum of \$58.47 be paid by the Village and a voucher therefor be issued by the proper officers in favor of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. That the Clerk be, and hereby is, directed to certify a copy of this ordinance to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
