To prohibit the sale and use of fireworks within the Village of Bexley, Onio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That no person, firm or corporation shall, within the Village of Bexley, Ohio, sell, offer for sale or give away or have in his or its possession, custody or control for the purpose of selling or giving away in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, any toy pistol, squib, rocket, fire-cracker, roman candle, fire-balloon, or other combustible fireworks, or any article for the making of a pyrotechnic display. Provided, however, that nothing in this section contained shall be construeded to prohibit the mayor from authorizing pyrotechnic displays of fireworks in the parks or other public places whenever so as thorized by resolution of council. y Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a minimum and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$25.40.
