## AN ORDINANCE NO. 619

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 548 to levy special assessments for the construction and installation of a system of lighting for certain streets and avenues in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, duly passed on January 13th, 1925, there was assessed against John S. Wilkins and R. A. Wilkins, on part of Lot Number Three (3) of Edward Livingston's Heirs Subdivision in said Village, fronting 229.35 feet upon Collage ave, the sum of One Hundred Eighty-eight Dollars and Twenty-three Cents (\$188.23) wherein by mistake all of said frontage was charged against said John S. Wilkins and A. R. Wilkins, whereas they owned but 114.45 feet fronting on said street and the balance, to-wit: the sum of Ninety-four Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$94.30), leaving a balance of Ninety-three Dollars and Ninety-three Cents (\$93.93) which should have been assessed against said John S. and R. A. Wilkins, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY. STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Ninety-four Dollars and Thirty Cents (\$94.30) and interest on said amount be striken from said assessment against said John S. and R. A. Wilkins and the same be levied upon said 114.90 feet in the name of Ella M. Kinkead and that same be so entered upon the Treasurer's Duplicate of Franklin County, Ohio, and collected as provided in Ordinance No. 548.

Section 2. That copy of this Ordinance be certified to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
