

## ORDINANCE NO. 620.

SEMI-ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE. -- An Ordinance to make Appropriations for Current Expenses and other Expenditures of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, during the fiscal half year ending December 31, 1925.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, That, to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the said Village of Bexley during the fiscal half year ending December 31, 1925, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the General Fund:

Section 3. That there be appropriated from the Safety Fund:

Section 4. That there be appropriated from the Service Fund:

" Lighting	5000.00
Building Inspection	900.00
Garbage Collection	1000.00
Gas and Auto. Repairs	1000.00

Total for expenses of Service Fund \$9900.00

Section 5. That there be appropriated from the Water Fund:

Board	\$ 70.00
Clerk	1050.00
Meters and Services	3500.00
Water Supply	8000.00

Total for expenses of Water Fund \$12620.00

Total Appropriation ~~\$30080.00~~ 35775.00

Section 6. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the board or officers authorized by law to approve the same; or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for "Contingent Fund" can only be expended for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the specific appropriations herein made.
