AN ORDINANCE NO. 622

Determining to proceed with the construction of a trunk sanitary sewer in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 5 and to connect same with the sewers in Franklin County Sewer District, Truro No.1 jointly with the County of Franklin, State of Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed, jointly with the County of Franklin, with the construction of a trunk sanitary sewer in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 5 and to connect same with the sewers in Franklin County Sewer District, Truro No. 1, said sewer being the part hereinafter described of the sanitary sewers provided for in a general plan for a system of sewerage for the Village of Bexley embraced within said Sanitary. Sewer District No. 5, which general plan is on file in the office of the Clerk of said Village; that the portions of the work provided for in said general plan which it is hereby determined to construct is the trunk sewer shown upon the plan of said Sewer District No. 5, being in the alley east of Chelsea avenue, in Gould Read and extensions thereof, from Charles Street to the north Corporation line.

That part of said Sewer District No. 5 so to be improved being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the present north corporation line of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, said beginning point being the north-east corner of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3; thence with the present corporation line easterly; thence southerly; thence easterly; thence southerly and thence easterly to the intersection of the corporation line with the Marion-Truro Township line; thence Southerly with said township line (the same being the east corporation line) to a point in the center line of Charles Street; thence westerly with the center line of Charles Street to the center line of Chelsea Avenue; thence northerly with the center line of Chelsea Avenue to the center line of the first alley south of Main Street; thence westerly with the center line of said first alley south of Mair Street to the center line of Roosevelt Avenue; thence northerly with

the center line of Roosevelt Avenue to the center line of Main Street; thence westerly withthe center line of Main Street to a point where the same is intersected by the east boundary line of Sanitary Sewer District No. 4; thence northerly with the east boundary line of Sanitary Sewer Districts Nos. 4 and 3 to the place of beginning.

Section 2. Said sewer, together with the necessary house connections for each lot fronting and abutting upon said improvement shall be constructed pursuant to Resolution No. 483, adopted June 23rd, 1925, and in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the engineers of said Village and now on file in the office of the Clerk; that said sewer shall be 12, 15 and 18 inches in diameter and shall be of vitrified pipe.

Section 3. That the proportion of the cost of said improvement, to be apportioned to the Village of Bexley (being fifty per cent of the entire cost thereof), less two per cent (2%) of said apportionment, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon all the lots and lands lying within said part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 5 in said Village which is bereinabove described, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement in the amount of the cost thereof, said cost to include the expense of preliminary and other engineering services, surveys, printing and publishing of all required notices, resolutions, ordinances, the serving of notices, interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments obtaining the necessary right of ways, and all other necessary expenditures.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five annual installments, with the interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection thereof, provided that the owner of any property so assessed may, at its option, pay such assessments in cash within thirty days after the passage of the assessing ordinance.

Section 5. That the bonds of the Village of Bexley shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6. That the remainder of the partion of the cost of said improvement to be paid by the Village shall be paid from the proceeds of

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bonds of said Village issued in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. That the Clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement as provided by law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
