

AN ORDINANCE NO. 635.

Giving permission to Fred W. Herbst, Jr., to tap the six inch (6) water line at the intersection of Cassingham Road and Charles Street and to lay pipe from same to premises known as Lots Numbers One Hundred and Seven (107) and One Hundred and Eight (108) of Bexley Plaza Addition.

WHEREAS, Fred W. Herbst, Jr., owner of Lots Number One Hundred and Seven (107) and One Hundred and Eight (108) of Bexley Plaza Addition has petitioned for permission to tap the six inch (6) water line at the intersection of Cassingham Road and Charles Street and to run a water line therefrom, a distance of about eighty (80) feet to the above described premises for the service thereof, and has filed with Council a waiver in writing on behalf of himself, his heirs and assigns, agreeing with the Village that he will make said improvement at his own cost, under the direction of the Village Engineers and that when said Village shall construct a water line in the street upon which said lots abut, for the benefit of the territory including said lots, said above described premises may be assessed for their proper proportion of the cost of said water line and thereby waiving the right to claim exemption from such assessment on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BELEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said Fred W. Herbst, Jr., in consideration of said waiver and of said agreement is hereby granted permission to construct said water line and connect same with the six (6) inch water line at the intersection of Cassingham Road and Charles Street for the service of Lots Numbers One Hundred and Seven (107) and One Hundred and Eight (108) of Bexley Plaza Addition in the Village of Bexley, said work to be done under the supervision of the Village Engineers at the expense of said owner.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
