Accepting the plat of Ruhl Place and accepting and confirming the dedication of streets and avenues thereon shown.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BENLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That Ida May Ruhl and Celie E. Lind's plat of Ruhl Place, being a Subdivision of Lots Numbers Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24), Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31), except fifty (50) feet by 178.92 feet out of the northwest corner of said Lot Number Twenty-four (24) of the Subdivision of the estate of Anton Ruhl as recorded in Plat Book No. 8, page 7-A, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, be, and the same is hereby, approved and accepted and that the dedication to public use of the streets and avenues thereon shown be, and the same are hereby approved, accepted and confirmed.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
