ORDINANCE NO. 637.

By Mr. Lowrie.

To fix the price which The Columbus Gas and Fuel Company, its successors and assigns, may charge for natural gas furnished to consumers in the Village of Bexley. Onic.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY. STATE OF CHIO: Section 1. That during the period of three (3) years from the 1st. day of November, 1925, The Columbus Gas and Fuel Company, its successors and assigns, may charge each individual account appearing upon its books in any one month for natural gas furnished within the corporate limits of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, the following prices, to-wit: One Dollar (\$1.00) for the first one Thousand (1000) cubic feet or less of gas consumed each month; Fifty-five Cents (55c) per one thousand (1000) cubic feet for all over one thousand (1000) cubic feet of gas comsumed each month, with an additional charge of five cents (5c) per one thousand (1000) cubic feet where the bills are not paidon or before the 10th. day of the month following the month in which service is rendered. Provided, however, should a price less than the above rates be established for natural gas consumedin the City of Columbus at any time during said three (3) year period hereinabove provided, then and in that event the rate so established within the City of Columbus shall become and be the rate which may be charged for gas within the Village of Bexley during the rest of said three (3) year period in lieu of the rates hereinabove provided, and the above rates shall become and be null and void.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the explicit period allowed by law.
