

AN ORDINANCE NO. 639.

To provide for an additional ^{deputy} marshal in the Village of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the office of deputy marshal in addition to the deputy marshalls heretofore authorized by ordinance be , and the same is hereby, created and established; that the Mayor, subject to confirmation of Council, be, and hereby is empowered to appoint annually a suitable person as such deputy marshal of said village for such period of time as the Mayor may determine to be necessary; that the salary of said additional deputy marshal shall be One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month; and that such deputy marshal shall give bond according to law in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).


Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety within the Village of Bexley and is made necessary by the injuries to the present deputy marshal which have incapacitated him from performing temporarily the duties of his office.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
