To provide for an additional marshal in the Village of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF

JHIJ:

deputy marshalls neretofore authorized by ordinance be, and the same is hereby, created and established; that the anyor, subject to confirmation of Council, be, and nereby is empowered to appoint annually a suitable person as such deputy marshall of said village for such period of time as the anyor may determine to be necessary; that the salary of said additional deputy marshall shall be One Hundred and fifty Dollars (w150.00) per month; and that such deputy marshall shall be one shall give sond according to law in the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (w500.00).

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an omergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace and safety within the Village of Bexley and is made necessary by the injuries to the present deputy marshal which have incapatitated him from performing temporarily the duties of his office.
