

AN ORDINANCE NO. 640.

Confirming appointment of J. H. Gray as deputy marshal.

WHEREAS, under authority of Ordinance No. 639, duly passed on the 22nd. day of September, 1925, the Mayor has appointed Mr. J. H. Gray as Deputy Marshal of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to serve until the 31st. day of December, 1925, at a salary of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month, and

WHEREAS, Council is of the opinion that said appointment should be approved and confirmed, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the appointment of Mr. J. H. Gray as Deputy Marshal of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to serve until the 31st. day of December, 1925, be, and the same is hereby confirmed.

Section 2. That the money necessary to pay the salary of said deputy marshal in the sum of \$450.00 be and the same is hereby appropriated for that purpose from the Safety Fund.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
