ORDINANCE NO. 643.

To amend Section 15 of Ordinance No. 450 to regulate traffic on the public highways of the Village of Bexley, and %c repeal all ordinances in conflict therewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO; Section 1. That Section 15 of Ordinance No. 450 to regulate traffic on the public highways of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, and to repeal all ordinances in conflict therwith, passed October 9th, 1923, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 14. GENERAL PENALTIES.

- (a) Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished, unless otherwise specifically provided in this ordinance, by a fine of not less than five dollars and not more than twenty-five dollars, and for the second or subsequent offense shall be fined not less than ten dollars and not more than fifty dollars.
 - (b) All fines shall go to the someral fund.
- (c) For violation of paragraphs (a) and (b) of Section 4 any person may, upon conviction, for a first offense thereof be fixed not less than five dollars or more than one hundred dollars; and for a second offense, not less than ten dollars or more than one hundred dollars; and for a third offense, not less fiftyen dollars or more thantwo hundred dollars, and may be deprived of the right to drive on the streets of the Village of Bexley for a period not less than thirty days nor more than ninety days.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
