

ORDINANCE NO. 644.

By Mr. Manly:

To purchase street signs for the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village purchase fifty (50) street signs complete, containing the names of streets and numbers to be furnished by the Clerk, also five (5) posts for street signs, said signs and posts to be according to the plans and specifications prepared by the engineers of the Village and being the same as the Columbus, Ohio, standard sign.

Section 2. That therebe, and hereby is appropriated from the general fund of said Village the sum of \$1,000 for the purchase of said signs and posts.

Section 3. That the clerk be, and hereby is, authorized to advertise for bids for said signs and posts according to law.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
