AN ORDINANCE NO. 648.

OHIO:

authorizing the borrowing of money and issuing of notes of the Village of Bexley, Onio, in anticipation of the levy of special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF

Section 1. That the Village of Bexley, Chio, be, and hereby is authorized to borrow money in the sum of Eleven housand Dollars (\$11,000) and to issue the notes of said Village therefor in anticipation of the levy of special assessments and the issuing of bonds in anticipation of the collection of said assessments as provided by Section 3914 General Code, to pay that part of the cost heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the construction of sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 3 as follows:

- (a) A ten inch sewer in Maryland Avenue from the existing trunk sewer in Stanbery Avenue to Walnut Street.
- (b) an eight (8) inch sewer in Walnut Street from Maryland Avenue to Caroline Avenue.
- (c) an eight (8) inch sewer in Caroline Avenue from the alley east of Drexel Avenue to the alley east of Dawson Avenue.
- (d) An eight (8) inch sewer in the alley east of Drexel Avenue from Garoline Avenue to Delmar Drive.
- (e)An eight (8) inch sewer in the alley east of Walnut Street from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive.
- (f) An eight (8) inch sewer in the alley east of D on Avenue from Caroline Avenue to Delmar Drive, as provided by Resolution No. 467, declaring the necessity therefor, adopted on the 26th day of May, 1925, and in pursuance of an Ordinance No. 627, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed August 11th, 1925.

Section 2. That said notes shall be in denominations of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, or any multiple thereof, or such smaller denomination as may be necessary, shall be signed by the mayor, attested by the clerk, be sealed with the seal of the Village, bear date as issued and shall be due and payable not later than two years from date of issue. Said notes shall be numbered consecutively beginning with number one (1) and shall bear

interest at the lowest wate obtainable, but not in excess of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually. The proceeds of the bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments, and all of the assessments collected for said improvement, shall, be applied to the payment of said notes and interest thereon until both are fully paid, and thereafter said assessments shall be applied to the payment of said bonds and interest thereon.

Section 3. That the Finance Committee of this Council shall cause said notes to be properly prepared, executed and sold according to law to the person, persons, company or corporation offering the lowest rate of interest, and shall deposit the proceeds in the Village Treasury to the credit of Sundry Sewer Improvement Fund.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
