

AN ORDINANCE NO. 649.

To amend Ordinance No. 621, establishing a Building Code for the Village of Bexley, Ohio, by adding thereto Section 3 (h).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 621 to establish a Building Code for the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed July 14th, 1925, be amended by adding thereto Section 3 (h) as follows, to-wit:


Section 3(h). The Building Inspector shall inspect or cause to be inspected all public school buildings, public halls, churches, theaters, buildings either for manufacturing or commercial purposes, hotels, apartment houses and other buildings or structures occupied or frequented by large numbers of people, for the purpose of determining the safety of such buildings or any parts or appliances or equipment thereof, the sufficiency of their doors, passageways, aisles, stairways, corridors, exits or fire escapes and generally their facilities for egress in case of fire, panic or other accidents, and the strength of their floors, as required in this ordinance, and by statute.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
