

AN ORDINANCE NO. 655.

To amend Ordinance No. 621, establishing a Building Code for the Village of Bexley, Ohio, by adding thereto Section 3 (h).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF ~~OHIO~~
OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 621 to establish a Building Code for the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed July 14th, 1925, be amended by adding thereto Section 3 (h) as follows, to-wit:

Section 3 (h). That the regulations contained in this Code shall apply to all buildings erected, altered or repaired, and in addition to the provisions of the State Building Code of Ohio, covering the erection of theatres and assembly halls, motion picture theatres, school buildings, standard devices and sanitation, and such additional building regulations as may hereafter be adopted by the State of Ohio, and are also in addition to the provisions of any Plumbing Code of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, which may be authorized by the Village Council.

The Building Inspector shall inspect or cause to be inspected all public school buildings, public halls, churches, theaters, buildings either for manufacturing or commercial purposes, hotels, apartment houses and other buildings or structures occupied or frequented by large numbers of people, for the purpose of determining the safety of such buildings or any parts or appliances or equipment thereof, the sufficiency of their doors, passageways, aisles, stairways, corridors, exits or fire escapes and generally their facilities for egress in case of fire, panic or other accidents, and the strength of their floors, as required in this ordinance.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 649, passed November 25th, 1925, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
