RESOLUTION NO. 531.

To amend Resolution No. 434 providing for the adoption of a general plan for a system of sewerage for Sewer District No. 6.

WHEREAS, on the 7th day of October, 1924, the Council of the Village of Bexley, Onio, duly adopted Resolution No. 434, providing for a general plan for a system of sewerage for Sewer District No. 6 embracing the following described territory, to-wit:

Being the territory bounded on the south by the center line of Broad Street, on the west by Alum Creek, on the north by the north line of Clifton Avenue and on the east by the west line of Bullitt Park Addition, and

WHEREAS, on the 12th day of January, 1926, Robert H. Jeffrey, the owner of the premises hereinafter described filed his petition with the Council asking that said Sewer District No. 6 be amended so as to include the following described premises and agreeing and requesting in said petition that the cost of said improvement and of the operation and maintenance of the same should be assessed and collected in equal annual installments, according to the benefits upon all the lots and lands benefitted thereby, including said premises of said petiticner and that said assessments may be levied and collected without reference to the value of the property of said petitioner, and waiving all benefits of provisions of Sections 3814, 3818 and 3895 of the General Code providing for the service and publication of notices of proceedings for the construction of said improvement and making and levying of the assessment therefor, together with all questions affecting the legality of the proceedings of Council whereby said improvement is made and said assessments are levied as so petitioned for, said premises being described as follows, tê-wit:

Located in the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, and

Beginning at a point in the north line of Clifton Avenue 270.6 feet west of the west line of Bullitt Park Addition 1078.21 feet to a point; thence westerly along Huggins south line 310 feet to a point; thence westerly along Huggins west line 320 feet to a point; thence westerly 575 feet to the center of Alum Creek; thence southerly with the center of said creek to the north line of Clifton Avenue; thence easterly with the north line of Clifton Avenue to the place of beginning,

said petitioner also asking that he be given permission to connect wait sanitary sewers in said territory with the sewers, pumping station and discharge line now being constructed in said Sewer District No. 6, and

WHEREAS, Council is nof the opinion that said petition should be granted and said Sewer District No. 6 amended so as to include said territory and

the engineers of said village have amended the plans of said District so as to include said territory, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That said plan as so amended for said Sewer District No. 6 of the

Village of Bexley, be, and the same is hereby, approved and confirmed and placed

on file in the office of the Clerk.

Be it further resolved that said Robert H. Jeffrey is hereby given permission to connect the sanitary sewers in said territory with the sewers, pumping station and discharge line now being constructed in said territory sanitary sewer district under authority and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 552, determining to proceed with the sonstruction of sanitary sewers and pumping station in said Sewer District No. 6, passed on the 13th day of January, 1925.

Be it further resolved that in accordance with said petition that the cost of said improvement and the operation and maintenance of the same be assessed and collected in equal annual installments according to the benefits upon the lots and lands benefitted thereby, including said premises hereinabove described.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
