RESOLUTION NO. 586.

By Mr. Pretzman.

To provide for lighting certain streets in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, and for levying and collecting special assessments therefor.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it hereby is declared to be necessary to provide for lighting the following streets in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to-wit:

- (a) Sheridan Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Main Street.
- (b) Dawson Avenue from Broad Street to Fair Avenue.
- (c) Cassady Avenue from Broad Street to Fair Avenue.
- (d) Ardmore Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue.
- (e) Cassingham Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue.
- (f) Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Cassingham Road.
- (g) Bexford Place from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.
- (h) Powell Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.
- (i) Seneca Park Place from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.
- (j) Elm Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.
- (k) Dale Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.
- (l) Plymouth Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.

Section 2. That the entire cost of constructing and installing said system for lighting said streets and avenues, except, one-fiftieth thereof, and the cost of intersections, shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements on all the lots and lands bounding, fronting, and abutting upon said proposed improvements between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine or more than ten equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 4. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay the estimated cost of said improvement.

Section 5. That notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be given to the owners of the lots and lands to be assessed for the payment of the cost and expense of such lighting, by publication thereof in any newspaper printed in Ohio and of General circulation in the Village, for the period of fifteen days prior to the taking effect thereof.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Resolution No. 536, To provide for lighting certain streets in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, and for levying and collecting special assessments therefor.

Be It Resolved, By the council of the Village of Bexley, state of Ohio:

Section 1. That it hereby is declared to be necessary to provide for lighting the following streets in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, to-wit:

- (a) Sheridan Ave. from Livingston Ave. to Main St.
- (b) Dawson Ave. from Broad St. to Fair Ave.
- (c) Cassady Ave. from Broad St. to Fair Ave.
- (d) Ardmore Road from Broad St. to Fair Ave.
- (e) Cassingham Road from Broad St. to Fair Ave.
- (f) Fair Ave. from Drexel Ave. to Cassingham Road.
- (g) Bexford Place from Dawson Ave. to Cassady Ave.
- (h) Fowell Ave. from Dawson Ave. to Cassady Ave.
- (i) Seneca Park Place from Dawson Ave. to Cassady Ave.
- (j) Elm Ave. from Dawson Ave. to Cassady Ave.
- (k) Dale Ave. from Dawson Ave. to Cassady Ave.
- (l) Plymouth Ave. from Dawson Ave. to Cassady Ave.

Sec. 2. That the entire cost of constructing and installing said system for lighting said streets and avenues, except one-fiftieth thereof, and the cost of intersections, shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements on all the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvements between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Sec. 3. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine or more than twelve annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Sec. 4. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay the estimated cost of said improvement.

Sec. 5. That notice of the adoption of this resolution shall be given to the owners of the lots and lands to be assessed for the payment of the cost and expense of such lighting, by publication thereof in any newspaper printed in Ohio and of general circulation in the village, for the period of 15 days prior to the taking effect thereof.

Sec. 6. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
