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AN ORDINANCE NO 668

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Remington Road from Broad Street to a point 174 feet south of the south line of Powell Avenue in the Village of Bexley.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Remington Road from Broad Street to a point 174 feet south of the south line of Powell Avenue, by grading, curbing and improving the roadway thereof with asphalt, constructing sewers and drains necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and erecting street signs, pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 576, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 27th day of March, 1925, amounting in the aggregate to Nineteen Thousand, Eight Hundred Dollars (\$19, 800.00), as reported to this Council on the 14th day of December, 1925, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessments hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this Ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in nine annual installments with interest at the rate of 5% per annum, from October 1st, 1926. All cash payments shall be made to the Treasurer of said Village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax Duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
