

ORDINANCE NO. 669.

AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS FOR SINKING FUND AND OTHER EXPENDITURES OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1926.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, That, to provide for the Sinking Fund and other expenditures of the said Village of Bexley during the fiscal half year ending December 31, 1926, the following sums be and they are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows, viz:

Section 2. That there be appropriated from the Maintenance and Repair of Streets Fund \$9,072.50

Section 3. That there be appropriated for the Sinking Fund

General - Interest on bonds	\$80,000.00
" - Principal " "	55,000.00
Salary of Secretary	720.00
Office Expenses	150.00
Spec. assess. - Interest on Bonds	150,000.00
" " - Principal " "	<u>300,000.00</u>
Total for Sinking Fund	\$585,870.00
Total appropriation	\$594,942.50

Section 4. And the Village Clerk is hereby authorized to draw his warrants on the Village Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers therefor, approved by the Board or officers authorized by law to approve the same; or an ordinance or resolution of council to make the expenditures; provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except to persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance. Provided further that the appropriation for "Contingent Fund" can only be expended for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than those covered by the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
