Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving columbia avenue between Maryland Avenue and Caroline Avenue, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein with necessary fire hydrants and water connections, pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 634, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed by Council on the 8th day of September, 1925, amounting in the aggregate to Thirty Theorem One 3/00 of January, 1926, by the Board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessments has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:
