AN ORDINANCE NO. 703.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Cassingham Road from Maryland Avenue to Ruhl Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:
Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the
improvement of Cassingham Road between Maryland avenue and Ruhl Avenue, by grading,
curbing and paving the roadway thereof with briak, asphalt, concrete or some other
form of permanent improvement, constructing a water line therein with necessary
fire hydrants of such capacity to furnish water to the property fronting and
abutting upon said improvement, and constructing the necessary sewer or drains to
furnish proper drainage for such improvement and erecting street signs, in
pursuance of a Resolution No. 539, declaring it necessary to improve said road,
adopted February 25th, 1925, and in accordance with the plans, specifications,
estimates and profiles heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the
Village Clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from said improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the improvement amd the solicitor hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of Competent Jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in an arrange equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be

payable not later than two years from the date of issue, in anticipation of the levy of special assessments and of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection thereof as provided in Section 5914 of the General Code of Ohio. Said

notes shall not exceed in amount that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which said special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That bonds of said village shall be issued, in anticipation of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the property fronting and abutting thereon.

Section 7. That the village's portion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds, issued by said village in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. That the Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
