

AN ORDINANCE NO. 729.

Accepting deed of easement of The Huntington National Bank of Columbus, Ohio, Trustee, for sewer, gas, telephone and electric light purposes.

WHEREAS, The Huntington National Bank of Columbus, Ohio, Trustee, has executed its deed of easement to the Village of Bexley, its successors and assigns, for a right of way over and through the following real estate, to-wit:

Situate in the Village of Bexley, County of Franklin, State of Ohio and described as follows:

Being a strip of ground eight (8) feet in width off of the east end of Lots Numbers One Hundred and Five to One Hundred and Thirteen (105 to 113) both inclusive, and eight (8) feet off of the east side of Lot Number Twenty-four (24) of Beacon Hill Addition in said Village of Bexley, as said lots are numbered and delineated upon the recorded plat thereof, of record in Plat Book No. 16, page 12, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio,

for the purpose of constructing, operating, maintaining and repairing sewer and gas lines, telephone and electric light and power poles, wires and cables, and


WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest of the Village to accept said conveyance, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the deed of easement of said the Huntington National Bank of Columbus, Ohio, Trustee, bearing date of March 18th, 1926, conveying to the Village of Bexley easement in and through the above described premises, for the purpose hereinabove mentioned, be, and the same is hereby, accepted, and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed an acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
