AN ORDINANCE NO. 733.

Nillage of Bexley, Onio, in anticipation of the levy of special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewer for the sewerage of part of District No. 3.

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore, by Ordinance No. 692, passed on March 9th, 1926, authorized the borrowing of money in the sum of Forty-four Hundred Dollars (\$4400.00) and is suing of the notes of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the same in anticipation of the levy of special assessments for the construction of sanitary sewer as provided by Resolution No. 527, declaring the necessity for said improvement, adopted January 26th, 1926, and in pursuance of an Ordinance No. 684, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed February 25th, 1926, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said amount so borrowed is insufficient to complete said improvement and that it will be necessary to borrow an additional sum of one Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in anticipation of the levy of said assessments for said improvement, NOW, THEREFURE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEALEY, STATE OF OHIO:

borrow an additional sum of \$1,000.00 and to issue the notes of the Village therefor, in anticipation of the levy of special assessments and the issuing of bonds in anticipation of the collection of said assessments as provided by Section 3914 General Code, to pay the costs neretofore determined to be specially assessed for the construction of a sanitary sewer for the sewerage of part of District No. 3, as provided by Resolution No. 527, declaring the necessity therefor, adopted January, 26th, 1926, and in pursuance of an Ordinance No. 684, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed February 25th, 1926.

Section 2. That said notes shall be in denominations of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) each, or any multiple thereof, or such smaller denomination as may be necessary, shall be signed by the Mayor, attested by the Clerk, be sealed with the seal of the Village, bear date as issued and shall be due and payable not later than two years from date of issue. Daid notes shall be numbered consecutively beginning with number one (1) and shall bear interest at the lowest rate obtainable, but not in excess of dy per annum, payable semi-annually. The proceeds of the bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments, and all of the assessments collected for said improvement, shall be applied to the payment of said notes and interest thereon until both are fully paid, and thereafter said assessments shall be applied to the payment of said bonds and interest thereon.

Section 3. That the Finance Committee of this Council shall cause said notes to be properly prepared, executed and sold according to law to the person, persons, company or corporation offering the lowest rate of interest, and shall deposit the proceeds in the Village Treasury to the credit of Sundry Sewer Improvement Fund.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
