All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax Duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
