AN ORDINANCE NO. 737.

By Mr. Pretzman.

To prohibit littering of public highways within the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to distribute, throw or deposit, or cause to be distributed, thrown or deposited in or upon any street, alley, public way or public place, within said Village, any poster or hand bills used for the purpose of advertising; or to throw, drop, deposit or leave in or upon any part of any street, alley, public way or public place, or in or upon any unenclosed private or public grounds in said village, any waste paper, hay, straw, rags, ashes, stable manure, garbage, rubbish or other refuse matters of any kind or description; or in any manner to permit any stone, brick, dirt, ashes, garbage, rubbish or decaying matter of any kind to fall from any wagon, cart or vehicle under his control upon any street, avenue, alley or public place or upon any lot; and it shall further be unlawful for any person to convey or carry through any street, avenue, alley or other public place any liquid, refuse matter or slops of any kind unless the same is conveyed in water tight wagons, carts, vehicles or vessels.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than \$5.00, nor more than \$25.00.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
