

Ordinance No. 739.

WHEREAS, the owners of the lots and lands abutting upon Bryden Road, between Drexel Avenue and Cassidy Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, have entered into an agreement among themselves to contribute to a fund wherewith to pay the cost of the material to re-surface with crushed stone and tarvia, or other similar re-surfacing material, Bryden Road between Drexel Avenue and Cassidy Avenue, and

WHEREAS, said abutting owners have proposed to the council of the Village of Bexley, that with said funds so subscribed they will purchase the necessary crushed stone, tarvia or other material necessary for patching the holes in said street and for re-surfacing said street between the points above designated, and will cause said material to be delivered on the street and said tarvia to be spread thereon, in consideration that said Village shall furnish and pay for the labor required for cleaning, sweeping and patching said street preparatory to making said repair, and the labor for applying the re-surfacing material on said street, and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the council of the Village of Bexley, that said proposal should be accepted and said patching and re-surfacing done, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, OHIO:


Section 1. That said proposal of the owners of premises abutting upon said Bryden Road, between Drexel Avenue and Cassidy Avenue, be, and the same is hereby accepted, and that upon the delivery upon said street of the materials hereinabove specified the street commissioner shall employ the necessary labor for the cleaning, sweeping, and patching of said street preparatory to making said repairs, also for applying said re-surfacing material on said street, said labor not to exceed Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250) in cost; and that said work be done under the supervision of said street commissioner and of the engineers of said Village.

Section 2. That the cost of said labor shall be paid out of the Street Repair Fund for which purpose the necessary amount, not to exceed \$250.00, is hereby appropriated.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
