

ORDINANCE NO. 744.

Accepting deed of easement of the Southern Ohio Public Service Company for water main purposes.

WHEREAS, the Southern Ohio Public Service Company, of Zanesville, Ohio, has executed its deed of easement to the Village of Bexley, its successors and assigns, for the right to construct, operate and maintain a sixteen (16) inch water main over and through the right of way of said Southern Ohio Public Service Company in said Village, said main to be constructed parallel to the north line of said right of way and distant 49 feet southerly therefrom from the west line of College Avenue to a point 415 feet west of the present curb of Sheridan Avenue; thence in a southwesterly direction to Alum Creek, subject to rights and conditions therein mentioned, and

WHEREAS, it will be to the best interests of the Village to accept said deed of easement, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said deed of easement of said Southern Ohio Public Service Company, bearing date of May 14th, 1926, conveying to the Village an easement in and through the above mentioned premises, for the purposes hereinabove stated be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the Clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed of easement the acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
