

## ORDINANCE NO. 750.

To amend Section 2a of Article II of Ordinance No. 456 of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed October 23, 1923.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2a of Article II of Ordinance No. 456 of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, passed October 23, 1923, be amended as follows:

Sec. 2a. Class 1, or single family house districts. Any and all parts of said village and all lots lying therein not otherwise described, districted and classified by Ordinance of said Village, shall be Class 1 districts.

Section 2. Said original Section 2a of Article II of Ordinance No. 456 of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
